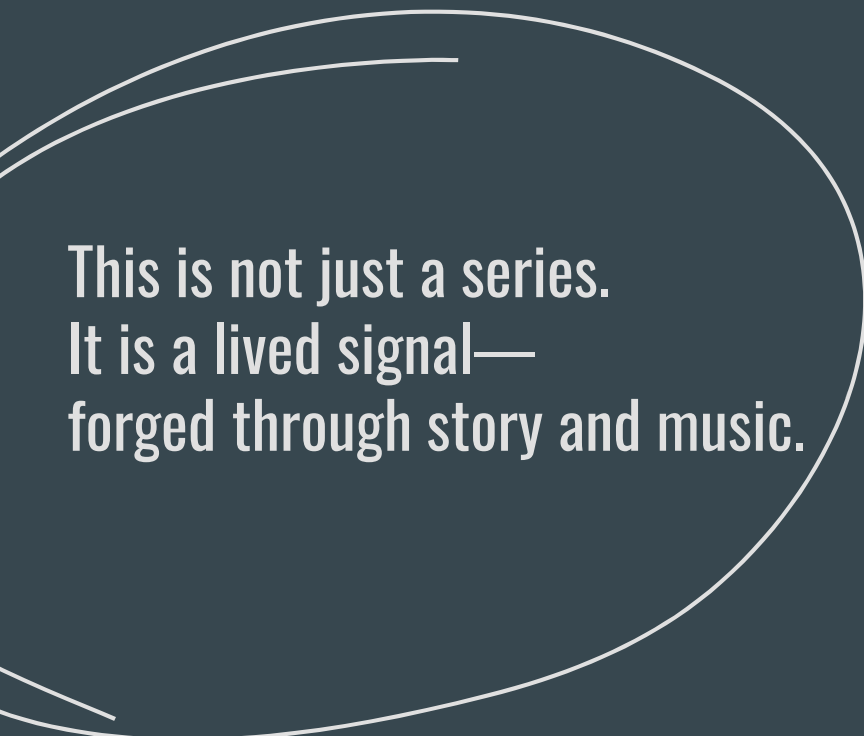

A young man's suicide attempt, while dying of AIDS in 2009, triggers an inter-dimensional therapy session with a mysterious being, forcing him to relive his trauma in a psychospiritual thriller rock opera where music is the weapon—and his story is the key to healing a fractured world.

SYNOPSIS

Based on a true story.

Growing up in Western Canada, Dreamer's desire for love and belonging drove him to make a series of bad decisions. On track to become a professional cellist, his world shattered before him with an HIV positive diagnosis in 1996.

We meet Dreamer in the palliative ward in 2009, lying in a hospital bed, waiting to die from AIDS.

It is through Dreamer's musical mind that we explore the tragedy that brought him to the brink of death and discover the hope for his future.

Every episode will take the viewer on a stunning musical journey through this fantastical story.

THE PILOT

In 2009, 33-year-old Dreamer is a skeletal ruin, haunted by a 1994 Polaroid of himself—a moment of unguarded joy captured by his predatory mentor, Chuck. Following a desperate suicide attempt, Dreamer is hospitalized in a palliative ward, his body failing from advanced AIDS. As the “static” of trauma threatens to silence him, a shimmering figure named T appears, offering a “signal” through the noise: a chance to reclaim the song he was forced to abandon.

While doctors witness a clinically irrational medical reversal, Dreamer undergoes a visceral transformation. In the dead of night, he manually forces his racing heart to sync with a steady, 60-BPM rhythm—a defiant act of will. This culminates in a sensory-shattering shower sequence where hospital tiles dissolve into a cosmic stage and the water’s roar becomes a thunderous rock-opera.

This “transfusion of will” stabilizes his body but comes with a daunting mission: to survive the present, he must perform a forensic audit of his past. The pilot concludes as Dreamer picks up a notepad and writes a single, commanding word: “LOUDER.” He is no longer a patient waiting for the end, but a resonant force ready to unmake the somatic habits that colonized his soul.

EPISODE CONCEPTS

PART 1 (FIVE EPISODES): "POOR SOUL"

A musician's suicide attempt triggers a cosmic intervention. As his body fails in a hospital, his mind is pulled into a breathtaking otherworld by T, an enigmatic guide who uses transcendent concerts to force a harrowing journey through the traumatic memories that brought him to the edge.

PART 2 (TWO EPISODES): "CHANGE"

Dreamer moves to a small town to study with a renowned cellist risking everything to get what he wants.

PART 3 (TWO EPISODES): "SWEET SHAME"

After coming to terms with the consequences of what he has done, Dreamer must decide if he will continue down this dark path to achieve his dreams.

PART 4 (TWO EPISODES): "DEATH SPELL FOR DAD"

Pushed to his breaking point by Chuck's manipulation and a dismissive father, Dreamer's despair turns to dark resolve. In a climactic act of rebellion, he channels his rage into a powerful, written incantation against his dad. This spell marks a terrifying turn, as Dreamer seeks to destroy the forces that control him.

PART 5 (THREE EPISODES): "ORANGE ULTIMATUM"

As Dreamer's father nears death, Chuck tightens his grip, pressuring Dreamer to move in and sever ties with Lisa. After the funeral, Dreamer channels his grief into a raw, transcendent cello performance—but Chuck's possessiveness only deepens, pushing Dreamer toward a breaking point between artistic ambition and personal sacrifice.

PART 6 (THREE EPISODES): "IMAGINARY YOU"

Reeling from a devastating HIV diagnosis, Dreamer's reality fractures. As he spirals through a hallucinatory Halloween party, his inner turmoil manifests in a nightmarish vision of a mechanized future. Guided by a final, compassionate vision of Zora, he confronts the ruins of his identity and takes a first, fragile step toward grasping his own humanity.

FUTURE SEASONS

SEASON 1

We journey with Dreamer through his troubled youth, and the broken relationships that lead to his HIV positive diagnosis in 1996.

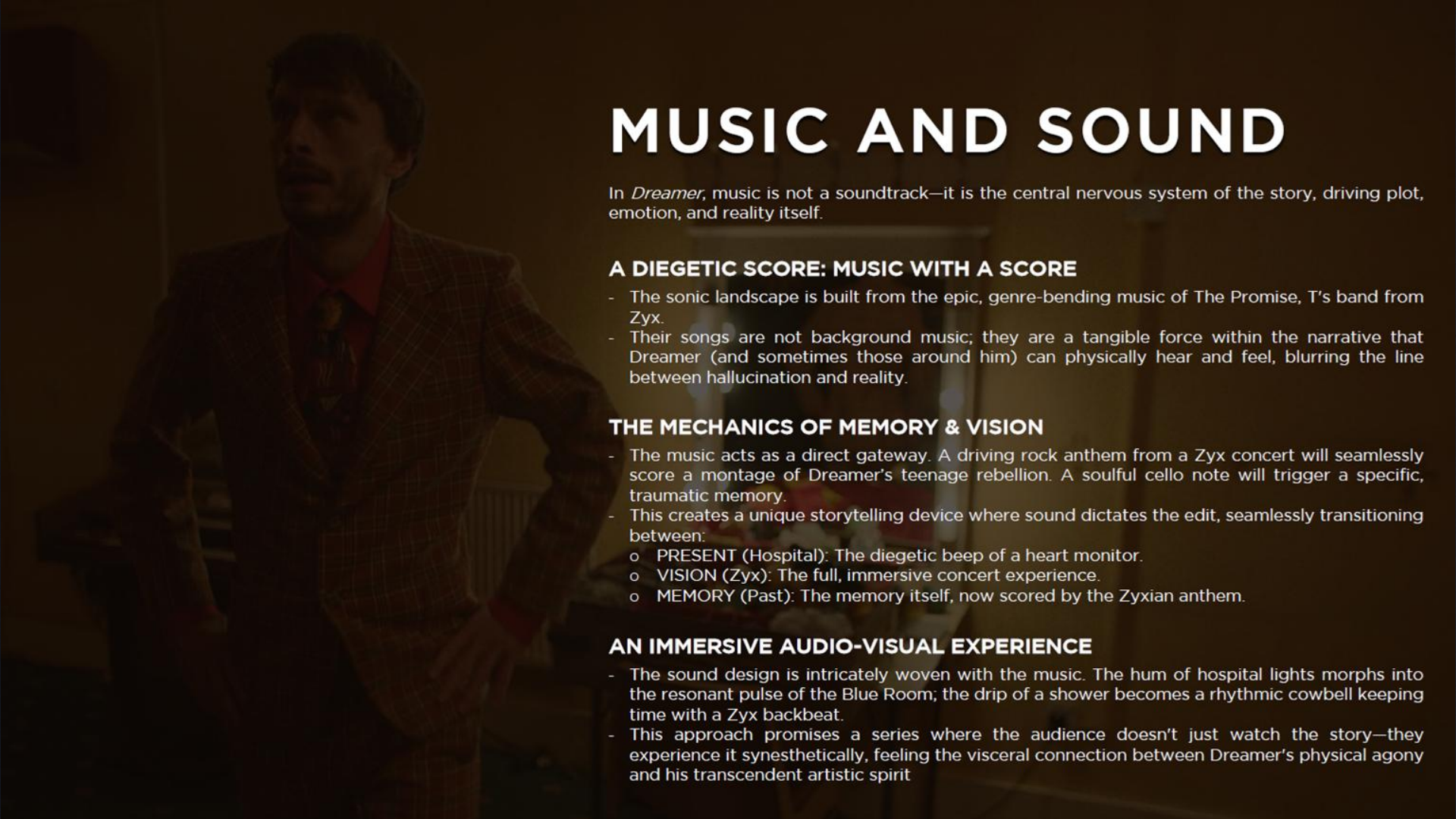
SEASON 2

Dreamer must face the reality of living in the 90's and 2000's as an HIV-positive man. He explores communities suffering, not only from the AIDS epidemic, but from around the world, and begins to come to terms with the larger reality of global inequality.

SEASON 3...AND MORE

DREAMER is the epic, true-story saga of a musician who must first completely shatter—succumbing to AIDS and the trauma of abuse—before he can be guided by a celestial being on a journey to reassemble his soul. His ultimate victory is not just surviving, but transforming his pain into a global movement of healing, finally fulfilling his youthful promise to 'mean something.'





MUSIC AND SOUND

In *Dreamer*, music is not a soundtrack—it is the central nervous system of the story, driving plot, emotion, and reality itself.

A DIEGETIC SCORE: MUSIC WITH A SCORE

- The sonic landscape is built from the epic, genre-bending music of The Promise, T's band from Zyx.
- Their songs are not background music; they are a tangible force within the narrative that Dreamer (and sometimes those around him) can physically hear and feel, blurring the line between hallucination and reality.

THE MECHANICS OF MEMORY & VISION

- The music acts as a direct gateway. A driving rock anthem from a Zyx concert will seamlessly score a montage of Dreamer's teenage rebellion. A soulful cello note will trigger a specific, traumatic memory.
- This creates a unique storytelling device where sound dictates the edit, seamlessly transitioning between:
 - o PRESENT (Hospital): The diegetic beep of a heart monitor.
 - o VISION (Zyx): The full, immersive concert experience.
 - o MEMORY (Past): The memory itself, now scored by the Zyxian anthem.

AN IMMERSIVE AUDIO-VISUAL EXPERIENCE

- The sound design is intricately woven with the music. The hum of hospital lights morphs into the resonant pulse of the Blue Room; the drip of a shower becomes a rhythmic cowbell keeping time with a Zyx backbeat.
- This approach promises a series where the audience doesn't just watch the story—they experience it synesthetically, feeling the visceral connection between Dreamer's physical agony and his transcendent artistic spirit.

Dreamer is a musician whose lifelong search for love and acceptance, shaped by abuse and a destructive affair with his mentor Chuck and leads him, after surviving AIDS and near death in 2009, to finally confront his trauma and learn he is worthy of love.

THE TEAM



TIMOTHY BARTSCH

CREATOR / WRITER / CO-SHOWRUNNER

Formed through classical training and classic rock influence, T (Timothy Bartsch) is a Toronto-based composer and performer whose life and art were profoundly shaped by his HIV diagnosis in 1996.

At 20, while studying cello at the Hochschule für Musik in Detmold, Germany, he learned he was HIV-positive and returned to Vancouver uncertain of his future. Turning from classical performance to songwriting, he began blending rock and classical forms into what he calls "psychedelic, jazzy-classical, musical-theateresque, art rock." His rock opera *Dreamer* chronicles how he contracted HIV, his years of spiritual and social transformation, and his near-fatal AIDS-related illness in 2009, followed by a remarkable recovery. After developing the work through stage productions and international performances, T formed the band The Promise as a statement to the world, to the future of humanity, the children of today — "Never again will the sun go down." This means — "We will do our best to provide a better world for you than the world we found ourselves in."

Their debut album, *Lost in Love No More*, premiered at the 2020 World AIDS Conference. With a mission to raise awareness and help end AIDS through music, Southern Time Productions is now preparing to begin preproduction on the first season of the *Dreamer* series.
